

Good afternoon Mark Twain students and families.

I hope this message finds all of you and your family members healthy and safe. We miss all of the students and are looking forward to school reopening.

Twain staff members have been working diligently to develop remote learning plans to provide students access to high quality learning activities and support from Pre- K through eighth grade.

The remote learning plan contains grade level access information, on-line learning resources, and teacher contact information along with a daily structure for learning activities.

Remote learning will begin Monday, April 13 and will remain in place until schools reopen. Students will be offered both digital and non-digital learning options, as well as dedicated “office hours”, where students and families can receive support from teachers.

All remote learning information will be shared with students and parents through email and on the Twain website- Twain.cps.edu. Hard copies of learning materials will be available at Twain Monday through Friday 9:00 am -1:00 pm at Door #1 for people unable to access online materials.

**Student Chromebooks and iPads are available to families in need of technology devices.**

Devices will be distributed through Door #3 on 52<sup>nd</sup> Street 8:30 am- 2:00pm according to the following schedule:

**Grades 6-8-Tuesday (4/7/20)    Grades 3-5 Wednesday (4/8/20)    PK-2- Thursday (4/9/20)**

Parent or Guardian will line up outside the building along the black fence

Parent or Guardian are the only individuals who may sign out a student device.

Parent or Guardian must bring a current ID or utility bill to verify identity to sign out a device

A Mobile Device Agreement must be signed by the parent or guardian for each student device received

All devices must be returned to the school at the end of the remote learning period.
