

Mark Twain School Lunchroom Rules

1. Students should respect and obey the teachers on duty and the lunchroom staff.
2. Students should stand in line quietly as they wait to enter the lunchroom, remember instruction is going on in nearby classrooms
3. All students must submit a ticket or enter their lunch number to receive a meal
4. As students enter the lunchroom, they should have their ticket or number ready, make their meal selections, proceed to their assigned table and remain seated until their lunch is finished at which time they may leave their seats to dump their tray.
5. Each student is responsible for cleaning their place at the table.
6. Students should bring only what they can eat. Leftover food or drinks may not be taken out of the lunchroom. No gum allowed. No glass containers please.
7. Throwing food or objects in the lunchroom is prohibited. This is a serious safety concern and will not be tolerated. All students involved will be removed from the lunchroom and subject to disciplinary action.
8. Trash and unwanted food items are to be disposed of in the proper garbage can.
9. Running, pushing, horseplay, arm wrestling, yelling and other types of disruptive behavior are not allowed.
10. Students must sit with their class at their assigned table unless otherwise assigned.
11. Students are allowed to talk in a conversational tone with their classmates sitting nearby.
12. Students are to remain seated with their class until they are directed to line up by an adult.
